Definitions

A medical instrument which uses very cold nitrogen to get rid of things like warts.

A measurement of the sugar in your body.

A medical instrument for listening to your heart, lungs, or other parts of the body.

Takes X-rays using radiation for the diagnosis and treatment of disease.

General Practitioner: the first doctor you see at the health service or clinic for a wide range of issues.

A chronic condition where your body has too much sugar.

Uses a handheld device to see detailed structures of the skin's surface.

Positive Pressure Ventilation uses a crucial technique to help newborns breathe if they aren't breathing well.

Stitching up a wound caused by an accident or surgery.

Rural Generalist: a specialist doctor who provides primary care, emergency, and other medical services in rural and remote areas.

Organs that control waste build up in the body, which is then gotten rid of by peeing.

A device that measures the force of blood against your artery walls to help find out if your heart is working well.

Emergency care for newborns who can't breathe or have a slow heart rate at birth.

Electrocardiogram: investigates how well your heart is working using electrical impulses.
